'Flavors of Oaxaca' Culinary Tour

with optional stopover in Mexico City (February 1 - 3, 2027)

The State of Oaxaca is one of the most magical places in Mexico, with a cultural richness drawn from its 15 distinct ethnic groups and languages. Walking the streets of the state capital, Oaxaca de Juárez, one begins to experience the local spirit and artistic creativity, including its live music and dance, great restaurants, colonial architecture like the Santo Domingo de Guzmán Church, vibrant marketplaces, as well as Monte Alban (a UNESCO World Heritage archeological site) and the Sierra Norte mountains with its beautiful nature retreats and hiking trails.

Below you will find the Tour Itinerary, which begins with an optional 2-day stopover in Mexico City.

A. TOUR ITINERARY.

Mexico City Stopover - February 1 - 3, 2027 [Optional] Mexico City has so much to offer. Even those who have visited many times love to return. Since there are few direct flights to Oaxaca (OAX), most of us fly to Mexico City (MEX) as the 'gateway city'. Using the opportunity, we offer a fun 2-day stopover package with group activities to enjoy one of the world's great cities. Then, on the afternoon of February 11th, we fly together to Oaxaca.

Oaxaca - Culinary & Cultural experiences

Day 1 - Wednesday, February 3 – Arrival in Oaxaca (OAX)

Mid-afternoon. Reception at airport / Hotel transfer / Check-in.

Evening. Optional dinner.

Leisurely neighborhood walk afterwards.

Day 2 - Thursday, February 4. Walking Tour of Oaxaca's Historic

Center Breakfast - included all 7 days

- **Walking tour** - We begin at the Santo Domingo Church and make our way to the Cathedral, Oaxaca Painters Gallery, and the main plaza (Zócalo).
- **Marketplace visits** – to the lively 'Benito Juárez' and '20 de Noviembre' markets.
- **Welcome Luncheon** @ *Las Quinze Letras Restaurant* – famous for its mole dishes ***

Day 3 - Friday, February 5. Day Trip to traditional villages

Meet craftsmen at nearby *pueblos* (towns) renown for their handicrafts.

- *Alebrijes* – intricately carved & painted wooden animals / Chat with artisans
- *Barro negro* – Black clay pottery atelier (Village of San Bartolo Coyotepec)
- Stop to see the 'Tule tree', reported to be the world's largest tree (in diameter)
Lunch break at Santa Maria del Tule
- *Mezcal* distillery
- Weaving artesans - beautiful *handcrafted rugs* (Village of Teotitlan)

Evening: free

Day 4 - Saturday, February 6. MONTE ALBÁN Tour & Gold Exhibit

8:30 am - Tour of world-famous Monte Alban archeological site led by our local guide. Return to hotel

1:30 pm – Main meal ('La Comida') at *Restaurante Tierra del Sol* ***

3:00 pm - **Santo Domingo Cultural Center**, including Monte Alban gold exhibit (led by WD)

Evening: free

Day 5 - Sunday, February 7. FLEX DAY / Cooking class & other options

- Optional *cooking class* that includes (i) a market visit to shop for fresh ingredients; (ii) *food preparation & cooking*, and (iii) a *meal together*.
- Spa option

Day 6 - Monday, February 8. All-day EXCURSION TO SIERRA NORTE including:

- Stop at Mirador observation point with a panoramic view of the valley,
- Guided hike in the forest with nature interpretation, and
- Visit to local indigenous village / *Home-cooked meal* ('La comida')

Day 7 - Tuesday, February 9. FREE DAY – Optional activities

- . Botanic Garden tour
- . Lithographic arts tour

- . Spa option

Mexico City Stopover (Optional – Nov. 12 - 14, 2025).

To make it easy for those wishing to make the stopover, we are offering a simplified package that includes:

- **Reception** at MEX Airport & **Transfer** to Hotel (Nov. 12th) at coordinated times
- **Hotel room** (Two nights / double occupancy)
- **Breakfast** (Two mornings)
- **Walking tour** of Alameda Park & Palacio Bellas Artes (Diego Rivera)
- **Chapultepec Park and National Museum** (Former Presidential Palace)
- **Transfer** from Hotel to Airport (MEX) for flight to Oaxaca (Nov. 14th)

Stopover package price: US\$490 pp / US\$150 Single supplement
